

Gapps android 7.1 2 nougat

MindTheGApps offers Open GApps and Beans GApps packages for Android versions. These can be found on Lineage's wiki page or archived at the Internet Archive. As of October 29, 2022, MindTheGApps is recommended over Open GApps since it stopped releasing new updates. Android Nougat 7.0: The final developer preview has been released, and Google announced the official release date for September 2016. Once Android Nougat is available for Nexus devices, Open GApps will be released in various sizes (80-90MB to 400MB) to install manually on AOSP-based ROMs like CM14. Nougat GApps are necessary since AOSP-based ROMs don't come with pre-installed Google services. You'll need to flash a compatible package from TWRP or another custom recovery. Installing Android Nougat GApps is similar to flashing any .zip file from a custom recovery. Below, you can find Nougat GApps packages from baNkS and OpenGapps: * Dynamic Nougat GApps (283 MB): A minimal package that includes Google Apps most users need or use. It's suitable for all Android 7.0 ROMs. * Mini Dynamic Nougat GApps: Supports ARM, ARM64 devices. For more packages, visit the dedicated page for Dynamic GApps for Nougat. OpenGapps also offers an Android 7.1 GApps package. Come pre-installed on Nexus 6P and 5X, these Nougat Gapps offer various packages for different users. For those who want a more comprehensive experience, there's Full Nougat Gapps (441 MB), which includes most Google apps and some additional ones not available on the Play Store. For a more streamlined package, try Mini Nougat Gapps (228 MB), which still offers popular Google apps and some extras. Micro Nougat Gapps (142 MB) is even more condensed, featuring only Gmail, Calendar, and Google Search, along with some other apps not found on the Play Store. The Nano package (91 MB) takes it down a notch further, offering only the Play Store app and required framework files. Finally, Pico Nougat Gapps (49 MB) provides just the bare minimum: the Play Store app. To install these Gapps, you'll need: * An Android 7.0 Nougat-based AOSP ROM like CM14 or Paranoid Android * A custom recovery like TWRP or CWM * At least 20% battery life on your device (installation won't take more than 3-5 minutes) * Ample free space (150MB or 500MB, depending on the package) on your device To install: 1. Download and transfer the Nougat Gapps package to your device 2. Boot into a custom recovery (TWRP preferably) 3. Install/Flash the Nougat Gapps package .zip file 4. Reboot phone 5. That's it! If you have any questions, feel free to ask in the comments section below. Quick Settings were not working and developer options were missing. Tapping repeatedly did not yield any results, not even a toast message. Reflashing the ROM with different Gapps resolved the issue, and QS tiles, dev options, etc., functioned properly. The error "Failed to find entry META-INF/com/google/android/updater-script in ZIP file" occurred while using certain Gapps. A possible solution was found by copying a dummy Updater Script from SupersU Zip into the folder, which resolved the problem for some users. Others reported issues with synchronizing contacts and optimizing Play Services, despite following instructions. The compatibility of these Gapps with Android 7.1 was also questioned, with some users experiencing difficulties. However, for others, everything worked fine except for a few minor issues.
