They started by creating vests in their garage, eventually moving to a small storefront on Julian St. Their business grew rapidly, necessitating larger spaces. By the early 1990s, they had expanded into a second room within the same building and soon outgrew it. A move to 969 Park Ave provided more space, but the demand for their products continued to rise. Customers' requests led Leather Masters to publish its first mail-order catalog in 1991. This move facilitated wholesale orders from other stores and eventually led to them supplying several retailers. In 1991, the owners of the building asked if they could purchase it, allowing Leather Masters to become its own property. Over the next couple years, they took over the entire building and sponsored three International Titleholders. The community's interest in their products and services prompted Leather Masters to conduct seminars on leather, BDSM lifestyles, and sexuality. In response to the growing online business market, they launched their website in 1996. In the early 2000s, while experiencing growth, Leather Masters faced significant economic challenges following the Dotcom market crash and the impact of September 11th. A lot of discussion took place before they decided to go ahead with the opening as planned in Allentown. They felt it was necessary to help stabilize the economy, especially since this store would be located on the East Coast. It wasn't an easy first year but they managed to survive and then things started picking up greatly. The store in Allentown ran successfully for 4 years before closing due to issues with the city. In 2004, a bar owner from San Antonio contacted them about opening a bar store there, which they agreed to do since it was close to one of their owners' mother's residence. However, 2005 was a tough year as both the Allentown and San Antonio stores had to shut down due to various reasons. During this time, they received an offer from Leather by Boots to buy out their store in Dallas, Texas. This opportunity allowed them to open Leather Masters in June 2005, combining their own expertise with Leather by Boots' 25-year history and unique designs. They have since been located in Dallas, specifically in the Deep Ellum area, for over 15 years. In 2019, after working together for over five years, Dave retired and MarKus Leather took over the company. They moved to a new location in Dallas into a 15,000 sq ft space. Unfortunately, due to COVID, Leather Masters was forced to shut down in 2020. However, it seems that this is not about Leather Masters but about Em City, which appears to be unrelated to the initial text provided. The Leather Masters experience has been overwhelmingly positive, with all employees displaying exceptional customer service and creating fantastic leather clothing that exceeded expectations.
